I wonder at a time when nations are set against nations and when the world is so divided why Scotland would want to split from England in the hope that Europe might support us with a surprising leap into the unknown. I also have come to realise how blessed the UK is that it split from the EU before the pandemic hit. If not we would be tied to controls which would have destroyed us in a system dominated by dark forces. If that is not clear to you look at the great speech by Greta Thunberg (the 17 year old Swedish schoolgirl) in the EU and the disgusting response by Jean Claude Junkers to highlight uniform standards for toilet flushing as a vital solution.
