

The Way of the Warrior 1

We are in a spiritual war. The war has been going on and now people realise that there is no more time to waste and all the evil forces we are up against are clear before us. This great spiritual war has become all the greater as a result of Covid and the way it has been used to dominate, delay and destroy. Date rape the latest news to me is Spiritual murder.

They rule this world and most of the institutions from the United Nations to international organisations like the EU and hold sway in the US in China and even much of the UK.” These are the words coming from the Great Spirit.

The small team in the teepee shrank at such words.

“We are only small and a tiny tribe what can we do against such powers?” Asked Maria.

“We must do what we have always done and remember what it is to be a warrior. Remember most of these forces just carry long shadows when you face them one to one often they are very weak and in a one to one battle we are the strongest tribe for we have the power of great and divine love.”

To be a warrior for this battle let us remember our trials and let us recognise the first steps we have taken:

1. We recognise that all life is connected as mentioned in the Earth Tree that tells us the way of giving and abundance just like an orchard. By giving we receive and so we are givers of truth and light, kindness and compassion. All creatures know this but only trees give to us all. – and so they planted a tree as their ritual before the battle. As they planted the tree they were surrounded by a great spiritual host all standing holding hands above the pool and acknowledging it as a beautiful lilac tree and a symbol of a great flowering, they witnessed the planting of the blueberry a sign of sweet fruits and two cowslips symbols of love.
2. We thank God for our strength and read and meditate. We share the bible and recognise its wisdom taken from many sources and maintained by an ancient people the Jews (which means to praise). We recognise the ancient wisdom from plants and through lots of studies from the ancient peoples and first nations from throughout the world. We also embrace technology and its ability to support us in our efforts too. However we must also remember we are the masters of technology otherwise it will destroy all life. We ask for guidance from the great spirit God as a mother and father.



3. We remember the first commandments of Jesus to love the love the lord your God with all your heart and mind and soul (which is all life on this earth and all the energy and matter in the universe.)
4. We remember the second commandments of Jesus to love your neighbour as yourself. This is to love all our fellow beings both animals and human. In Scotland we must love the English, the Irish, the Welsh the Shetlanders/Vikings these are our neighbours but also we must love all the nations and all the cultures. We must also love our enemies. We need not like them always but we should love them.
5. If we hold to these principles then we should ask for the father to bless us the mother to nurture us and Christ to become a part of us and enter our life. In this way we become one with love and we are blessed with the holy spirit and can begin our journey. We may do this alone but we should also witness this with others so that they also recognise our commitment to serve God. They can also do likewise and so we share our bond as warriors and servants and to learn humility.

The Spirit Warrior and Rainbow Gladiator stood up and began to dance a slow dance around the space they were in. We recognise Christ and we recognise the great spirit we recognise the animal spirits and the spirits of nature and we begin to prepare for our journey alone and together.

“Where ever you go I share with you the blessing of a restless peace. You will never be anxious as long as you follow our path of healing and change. We have the power to destroy strongholds of domination etc but I remind you to be as gentle as a dove and as wise as the serpent. Your colours may be your guide and we will share tribal badges.”

We commit to the following:

1. To follow a routine of daily exercise and healthy eating
2. To spend 1 hour every day learning about Nature, God and Jesus
3. To spend time in praise and building positive relationships
4. To spend 1 day per week in prayer and reflection in devotion to God.
5. To find a fellowship group which can help us prepare for our journey
6. To remain independent of thought but seek a deeper connection with those we trust who have the best interests for our welfare and positive and empowered growth.

The spirit Warrior man then said

“A good first step if you don’t know Jesus is to read his parables. I started with ladybird books and other simple stories. If you are going to study Jesus and his life do it at a Christian church like an evangelical church etc. and not in another place for there the words can be manipulated and made too simplistic. The church which is best is the one where the ministry and the fellowship are comfortable and you are encouraged to grow and ask questions and be part of a mixed fellowship.

Start by understanding the parables and the messages of Jesus christ is the unifying force of love in all religions. New age, and paganism is also a religion. Devote yourself to a fuller relationship with the messages from Jesus and his life and then consider if you want to be baptised with water as a public affirmation of your humility and service to Christ. Both churches and spiritual groups can be fake and can be misleading and cultish. They do this to get you to follow a man/woman and not christ as a spirit guiding our lives. They can seduce you with divination and prophecy etc.

You can join prayers in fellowship remember to focus on the love of nature and love of neighbour as yourself this is an act to be less self focused and from this see if you have any spiritual gifts like tongues, or prophecy or healing. Be aware some people speak in tongues or provide prophecy which is not from God. Remember God is love and love is giving nurturing and about empowerment especially female empowerment.

I have attended two churches one called PWAMM (like wigwam) and the other the church of the Nazarene. However neither recognise the importance of the divine feminine and so I am now focusing on attending St Marys in Birnam for my closest fellowships at present. I attend one bible study group at the Nazarene, both the Nazarene and PWAMM are run by men and I have concerns. As always dark forces seek to take over even safe havens like churches and so remain vigilant and test everone. I have no role or authority in either church and am concerned with some of the decision making and direction following recent meetings and this demonstrates the attacks we will face in the spiritual war.

It is best to start with one church however as you are starting to learn and grow. Your other group might be a nature group and that can be another way to discuss how God guides us and enters our lives. I am hoping to start a nature group going to the Hermitage and building a fellowship from that too.

How do we enter paradise? We do so by transforming our lives and serving the Lord God and following the path he has set for us. Then we are walking in faith to an ever greater paradise and relationship with God. The greatest servants become the greatest leaders always remembering that serving is through accountability and diligence and facing whatever challenges bravely and with integrity. Service is not top down management but inter relationship and partnership.

Some may call you a failure in many ways but to fail is to give up. Changing strategies is not giving up, just as I may be doing with my church groups. Walking by faith is not easy at first but not walking prevents any growth. After some time walking you can then run and then you can fight while running and in time you can become a great and powerful warrior.

I am a teacher now and my lessons are first to commit to Christ and become baptised and then to seek the deeper spiritual connections. Following the holy spirit allows you to remain in the light and build your spiritual power with other spiritual elements.

The second lesson will be to teach you about spirit stones and finding your nature spirit. This is like harry potter's Patronus charm. It is a manifestation of your holy spirit in a form you can work and grow with. This helps empower you and recognise your place on earth and how you might be growing and the spirit journey you are on. Many first nations accepted Christ like Pocahontas and this enriched their connection with God.

"Trying to link with spirits without the holy spirit opens you to demon possession and darkness and to be dominated by others. This can be very dangerous. Avoid the occult. Even some symbolism can be dangerous like putting your faith in controlling symbols. Nose and tongue peircing is bad for your energy system as it disturbs your bodies energy flows."

At this time we are being prepared to be married to Christ as brides. This means letting Christ into your life and becoming a happy servant. If you are not happy then you are not serving God as you could. Being happy does not mean you are comfortable but you should be content and feel you are following your higher purpose. Do not be misled being encouraged to do something you think is wrong or makes you feel like someones slave etc is not good for you.

"If you see christ in others then that is a sign of your union with him or her and you should follow that guidance and be confident in going in the direction of your dreams."

"God and Jesus wants you to live a life of abundance so discover what that means through the relationships you create and through following a higher purpose."

"We are here to reach the stars and are seeking star children ones who can help us with the next great journey."

For some this earth is just a staging post to the next kingdom and I will teach you about this as we work with our spirits and develop our fellowships. You should know I can travel between worlds as a spirit guide and mentor."

I hope this helps you on your journey and helps you find your way. Without understanding the teachings from Jesus and the prophets it is difficult to gain wisdom. Many religions are self obsessed or co-ercive and any religion that sets you against love in terms of the earth and kindness to others is not positive. If any actions by a church which are contrary to caring for others is also to be questioned. If you follow love then there you will find truth too. However love is not abusive and therefore it should be part of an open ministry.

We have great concerns with the use of a permissive agenda to orchestrate sexual immorality and coercion by the state towards unhealthy sexual acts from oral sex and anal sex to confusing the young by suggesting they are neither boys nor girls but can decide what type of person/creature they are. Be assured how God has made you is a divine blessing, and God and Jesus love you for your own uniqueness and do not consider you should conform to any kind of stereotype. I for one am a female man. I am giving and nurturing loving and emotional and I believe these are parts of my personal strengths as a man. I like to plant flowers and dance and sing and cook and I do not consider any of those things unmanly. As a man I can fight and like to take on tough challenges too like confronting bullies and climbing mountains. I am happy with my gentle spirit."

I write this as a personal guidance piece I do not pretend to state this as anything but my personal opinion and advice from many years following my Christian and environmentalist path. Many churches and christians pretend to have some new knowledge of the bible but much of this has come from me challenging churches on their scriptural teachings like homophobia, no sex before marriage and the attitude that God is a Man. All of these notions are twisted and used to control dominate and avoid following Gods two commandments to love God and to love your neighbour.

Remember Jesus did not have a church and did not establish one he developed a movement and when pushed to confront Rome he refused on the basis of Peace and so he was crucified by his own people.

His attitude was to take no more than he needed and as such emulates the natural non material world and a type of humanity which is mutualistic selfless and of a form before the fall of man.
